a. WWII medic and conscientious objector refused to carry a gun; saved an estimated 75 soldiers during the Battle of Okinawa.

b. New Zealand born climber who became the first person to climb Mount Everest.

c. A missionary in India who started an orphanage to rescue and protect children.

d. Former president of South Africa who dismantled apartheid and South Africa's nuclear weapons program.

e. The lone survivor of a plane crash in the Amazon, this 17 year old spent 10 days walking to escape the rainforest before being discovered and reunited with her father.

f. During Revolutionary War alerted Washington of an impending surprise attack after overhearing a meeting of British soldiers.

g. German Lutheran pastor who founded the Confessing Church. This person actively spoke out against and resisted Nazism and was arrested and executed in a concentration camp.

h. At 15 years old this person was shot in the head by the Taliban, survived, and became an advocate for women's education. At 17, youngest person to receive the Nobel Peace Prize.

i. Youngest person to sail solo around the world, finishing the journey at age 16.

j. Activist and first female Principal Chief of the modern Cherokee Nation; awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1998.
