You won't know unless you ask. I have learned again recently how true this is. Over the past several weeks I have been asked questions by the Community Schools Resource Coordinator, Cindy that I have then passed on to you. I have sent out text messages, emails and asked people in lifeGroup and Mom to Mom if they could help meet the practical needs of a couple of teachers at Leopold School. The questions have been can anyone help with housing? Does anyone have a bed, sheets, towels or house furnishings to share? Can anyone help with gas gift cards or groceries? You won't know unless you ask. And WOW!! God has moved in the hearts of you his people and you have been quick to respond, generous, kind, and the answer has been YES, and here's more!

We had housing arranged within 5 minutes of sending out a text. As it turned out, the teacher was able to secure an apartment and we didn't have to use the house. But just knowing that she had an option and would not need to sleep in her car with her three children brought her such hope.

Then we had another teacher, Maestro Silva who is here on a teacher exchange program from Colombia. He was able to move into his apartment, but had nothing to furnish it with. So, Cindy asked the Adopt a School Partners and the PFO and within 24 hours items were given, collected and distributed to him! He was blown away at the generosity and has also been able to share with some of the other teachers (there are 10 here from Colombia, Mexico and Venezuela, not all at Leopold).

This is a quote from a text from Cindy: "Andres got teary eyed when he saw all of the stuff. He said he will share with colleagues in the program. We are infinitely grateful." And here is a picture.

One of the families in my lifeGroup said they had a twin size bed and frame they could give. By the time (just the next day) I checked back in on the spreadsheet there was already a double bed given. So I checked back in with the other teacher with the 3 children and sure enough she was in need of a bed for one of her children. God knew we needed that twin size bed, I was able to deliver it and they were so, so grateful.

UNEXPECTED: QUESTIONS WHO DO PEOPLE SAY I AM?

WORD

Read Matthew 16:13-20

Read through the passage slowly - then read it again. (perhaps in more than one translation)

In between the readings ask the Holy Spirit to help you listen for a particular word or phrase that he wants to highlight for you.

Share what phrase jumped out at you and why you think it stood out to you today.

What answers to that question do you think you would hear today from a neighbor, friend, or possibly family member?

Who do YOU say that Jesus is?

PRAY

Ask God to reveal himself to those in your life that may be unsure of who Jesus is. Ask him to increase your confidence in who he is, and that you would be full of courage and boldness to share him with those around you.

LOVE

Who in your life needs to be reminded of the truth about who Jesus is? How will you share that with them this week?


