People who consciously count their blessings tend to be happier and less depressed. A complement to psychological counseling, the practice of gratitude is one of the activities that counselors are using. And, it is yielding high results.

Give thanks a try!

- Spend time at the beginning and end of each day to write down what you are thankful to. Keep it brief. 3 quick things as you begin the day. 3 quick thoughts about your day as you end it.
- Keep a gratitude journal for 31 days.
- Read Ann Voskamp's "One Thousand Gifts".

- Write one "Gratitude Letter" per week for a month. You don't even have to send it. Just write it.

RAVEN DELIVERY

1 Kings 17:1-7 (See 1 Kings 16:29-34 for context)

Focus: After delivering the news to the King that there was going to be a massive drought lasting years because of the King's actions, God tells Elijah to hide. And God sends him to camp near a brook, and sets up a delivery service for him, using ravens. So until the brook dried up, he had water and food delivered to him every day.


