During the month of November we have been learning about examples in God's Word of Unexpected Provision. Our God is amazing! We have also asked you where you have seen God provide in unexpected ways and many of you have written your examples on 3x5 cards or in the online chat during worship. Nothing is too hard or impossible for our God. He took a boy's small lunch and fed a crowd of thousands - a widow to feed a prophet - ravens to deliver food and water during a drought. What a mighty God we serve!

An unexpected provision that I have had the joy of being a part of is how this body of Christ has stepped forward to bless Leopold school.

- Abundance of items given to Maestro Silva who needed his apartment furnished and gas to drive to school.
- Every other week we have a consistent group of volunteers at the outdoor Food Pantry at Leopold that serves 70 to 80 families. (rain or shine, warm or cold)
- 35 pies (with a week notice) to partner with City on a Hill so 35 families could enjoy a Thanksgiving meal.
- Our preschool doing a food drive and winter clothes drive to give to Leopold families.
- Higher Ground had cereal night they brought cereal to eat and a box to share. Those were given to Leopold and enjoyed as snacks for the students

during the school day. (having enough snacks is an ongoing need at the school)

It is easy to think that what you can do won't make a difference. I'm sure the disciples didn't think that 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish would stretch to not only feed the crowd but have leftovers! God can take whatever we have, an hour of time, a smile to share, a hug to a friend, a listening ear, prayers lifted up for those in need and make a lasting impact.

#### **WARNING AND WOOD**

Genesis 6:9-22

Focus: The flood was coming. Noah was warned, and given instructions about the boat he needed to build, big enough for his family to live in along with ALL of the animals. He was going to need a LOT of wood.



## UNEXPECTED: ENDINGS SUBSTITUTE

#### WORD Read Genesis 22:1-14

Before these verses (skim through Genesis 21) what do you learn about the significance of Isaac's birth in the context of God's promise to Abraham?

How does Abraham react to God's command in verses 1-2? What does his immediate obedience reveal about his faith?

How does God intervene in verses 11-12 with the unexpected ending? What does this reveal about God's character and His relationship with Abraham?

How do these verses illustrate the concept of substitutionary sacrifice? Where else do you see this played out in scripture?

In what ways do you encounter tests of faith in your life, and how can the example of Abraham guide you in navigating these challenges?

#### **PRAY**

Take those challenges that were shared and turn them over to God in prayer. Ask for his help in increasing your faith and trust like Abraham. Give him thanks for always providing - especially in the life and death and resurrection of our Savior Jesus.

How will you show love this week to someone in your neighborhood?


