EMBRACING THE UNEXPECTED

James is the Vice Chair of the Church Leadership Board.

It comes as no surprise to many of you in our Church body that I'm a numbers guy. I've been an accountant specializing in nonprofit organizations for over nine years, and before that, I was a meteorologist from 2007 until 2014. Both deal with numbers, but in very different ways. Accounting is a Type A personality holder's dream: everything has its place and there are generally clear-cut rules to follow. Meteorology, on the other hand, relies on rounded spatial mathematics and equations that don't perfectly simulate our turbulent atmosphere. I grew up wanting to be a meteorologist, but ended up as an accountant through a series of life events. I expected one path, but was sent down a very different one.

Our theme this year has been all about the Unexpected. Every one of us has our unexpected moments – the vacation plan that went awry, a car accident that ate into the family nest egg, the list goes on. As my term on the Leadership Board is coming to an end at the end of December, I am taking a moment to reflect on how it has had its Unexpected moments.

Prior to joining the board, I had acted as the Church's outsourced accountant, and prior to that, as a volunteer helping with paying the bills. Upon joining the board, I was expecting a lot of the same, acting more or less like a Treasurer. Fun fact: our Leadership Board does not have a Treasurer. Suddenly, I was unexpectedly feeling out of my element. I was also not familiar with the Policy-Based Governance model our Church employs. While it has similarities to other methods of nonprofit board governance, it just wasn't what I was used to... or what I was expecting.

As time passed, I found myself becoming more used to the methods and actions of the Leadership Board, eventually acting as Vice-Chair last year and as Secretary in 2023. Yet, another unexpected event popped up: I was overextended. Job responsibilities, family events, kids in sports, sitting on two boards... I realized it was all too much and I knew I wasn't giving my best effort to any of them. I decided to cycle off the Leadership Board after my three-year tenure was complete at the end of this year, opting out of a second three-year term.

I didn't expect how hard the decision would be on me. It felt like I was giving up and throwing in the towel on what should be one of the most important aspects of my life: my faith journey. After prayerful consideration, I knew that I would continue to serve the Church in other ways and not completely disappear like a thief in the night.

My message to you: take your Unexpecteds to God. Sit with Him in prayer. When the Unexpected happens, I've found that two prayers work for me: asking God for strength to carry me through, and His will to be done and for me to accept the outcome. I'm not in control, He is. Knowing it's not my plan, but His plan, is sometimes all I need to keep pressing on. Those two prayers haven't broken through my Fear of Flying barrier, but I know they'll be part of the solution.

I know that Dave and Chad will do a wonderful job after my tenure wraps in a few weeks. I ask that you pray for them, and for their Unexpecteds. May your Advent and Christmas seasons be blessed, and I thank you for allowing me the opportunity to serve.


