Step in to 2024 with a fresh look at God's Word.

This month we kick off our 2024 theme: **ACTIVATE**

We begin our year-long theme by discovering what it means to be *sustained* by God's Word. The perfect place to start discovering God's Word is in your household. To help give you and your household a fresh perspective on the Bible - as well as a little fun - we invite you to engage with our Sustained by the Word BINGO game this month.

Make this activity your own - personalize and adapt it to fit your household.

Here are some suggestions on playing the game:

Does your household like a little healthy competition?

- Have a copy of the game board for each person in your household. Display them where everyone can see them.
- Have each person commit to finding a time daily to complete an activity from the game board.
- To complete an activity, roll 2 dice. Find the corresponding activity on the game board.
- · Complete the activity and cross it off of the game board.
- The first person to get a BINGO of 6 across or 6 down wins! Celebrate together!

Does your household need a game that brings you all together?

- Place one copy of the game board where it can be seen by everyone.
- As a household, set aside a time when you will come together each day to complete an activity. The household will complete one activity together each day.
- To complete an activity, roll 2 dice. Find the corresponding activity on the game board.
- · Complete the activity and cross it off of the game board.
- Celebrate when your household has completed a BINGO of 6 across or 6 down.

Does your household prefer a more cooperative game?

- Place one copy of the game board where it can be seen by everyone.
- Have each person commit to finding a time daily to complete an activity from the game board. Each person
 individually completes an activity but will contribute to crossing that activity off of the household game board.
- To complete an activity, roll 2 dice. Find the corresponding activity on the game board.
- · Complete the activity and cross it off of the game board.
- Decide when your household will celebrate? When the board is complete? When one column or row of 6
 activities has been completed by everyone in the household? Set a goal and celebrate when you reach it!

Read & Reflect: Proverbs 4:1-13 Compare Micah 6:6-8 and Hosea 6:6. What is God wanting to say to you today?



Read a parable from Luke 12 or 15 and retell it to someone.

Write down 5 insights: Joshua 1:1-9 Daniel explained a message to King Belshazzar. How was the message given to the King?

Write 1 Timothy 3:16-17 three times.

Read & Reflect: Romans 15:1-5



Illustrate Hebrews 4:12 How would you explain Acts 6:1-7 to a young child?

Write down 5 insights: Matthew 4:1-11 How old was King Josiah when he started restoring the temple?

Call someone who has been on your mind.

Find & memorize a verse about wisdom in Proverbs.



ACTIVATE FAITH: SUSTAINED BY THE WORD

John 8:30-47

Focus: The active life of a disciple is being Sustained by the Word. That includes reading and responding to God's Word daily, growing in our relationship with Jesus, prioritizing gathering for worship and worshiping privately, and being sharpened by God's Word in relationship with other Christians. Matthew 7:24 "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock."



ACTIVATE FAITH: SUSTAINED

WORD Read Exodus 16:1-21

Imagine how this might have been different if God had allowed extras that were gathered to not go bad?

What was God teaching His people through manna and quail?


