#### ESTABLISH A STEADY RHYTHM

Hopefully you were able to worship with us last Sunday, January 14th either in person or online. I was blessed by the message from Pastor Matt and challenged. He reminded us that God's word is for us personally and daily. The connection was made to the Old Testament and the children of Israel when God provided manna for them to nourish and sustain them and how God has provided His Word for us to nourish and sustain us. Jesus is the Bread of Life and the Living Water and we need Him, every hour we need him! (we sang that song on Sunday as well - thanks worship team for leading us in such meaningful singing of God's praises! If you missed it you can always go to the Church's Facebook page and watch the recorded service!)

There has been a simple question asked of us on the bookmark and screensaver for our cell phones, (you should have gotten an email about it this past week) Am I reading my Bible Daily? Seems like the easy answer to that for us would be YES! And yet, somehow, a day goes by here and there without reading God's Word. Surely we understand that it isn't just about reading the Bible to check it off of our to-do list, we want to meditate on it, consider how God is asking us to respond to what we have read so it impacts how we live our lives. We know how important it is, and understand that it is vital to our growth as children of God. So, why do we have stretches of not reading His word? There are many reasons and they are different for each of us. Most of us have good intentions, and start a reading plan and then something interrupts us, we get extra busy at work or with the kids or we get sick and then a few days turn into weeks. Or maybe we don't know where to start or what to read. (if that is true for you, please reach out and ask a friend to help you, start with one of the Gospels like Mark and focus on the life of Jesus)

I read a devotion by Ann Voskamp that was addressing New Year's resolutions and was struck by this phrase: *What you need more than splashy resolutions, is steady rhythms.* There it is! Establishing and carrying out steady rhythms. Just like any other habit, make it part of your daily routine and prioritize reading God's Word first before

you check your email or go on social media or play wordle. What other rhythm do you have that never gets missed? Cup of coffee and the morning news? Brushing your teeth? Taking your medicine or vitamins? What would it look like to get a steady rhythm of reading God's Word established in your life?

Maybe it is having a reminder on your phone. You can use an app on your phone and listen to God's word being read to you, Lectio365 or Pray as you Go or Dwell are some good ones to try. What if you text a friend that you are in a 1:1 relationship with and ask them what stood out to you today from your daily Bible reading? A good place to start is always with prayer. If you are struggling to get started or just not that interested, ask the Holy Spirit to help you have the desire to read God's Word and then to help you understand and apply it to your life.

Please hear this, God does not love you more because you read his word. This is not a legalistic mandate. God loves you no matter what. And nothing you do makes him love you more or less, He loves you! He longs to meet with you and remind you of those truths about who He is and who you are as His child. He wants to comfort you with his promises and fill you with hope and peace as you fix your thoughts on him and trust him. He wants you to know him better and better and that comes from reading His word and spending time with him in prayer. This is a get to thing not a have to thing. Meeting in lifeGroup is another great way to read God's Word with others and gain insight from what others are sharing. Perhaps you have fallen out of that steady rhythm and want to connect again to a lifeGroup - please reach out to me and I'll do my best to connect you to a group. (ameyer@livelifetogether.com)

John 6:25-35

### ACTIVATE FAITH: SUSTAINED ALIVE AND ACTIVE

### WORD Read Hebrews 4:12-16

What stands out to you about verses 12-13?

Read this scripture again, with the context that the Word being described here is not destructive, but it is a surgical instrument used by the most skilled physician, God. What stands out to you now? Does that change how these verses impact you?

How might this surgery look in your life? What might you do to activate

How is God inviting you to respond to His Word today?

#### **PRAY**

Pray for God to help you intentionally be in His Word, and to reflect upon it and respond as His Spirit leads. Ask Him to shape the desires of your heart, that you would appreciate and want His surgery in your life. Ask Him to illuminate the places in your life where you are not willing to have Him work. And ask Him to change your stubborn heart.

Think of someone you have been reluctant to help or show love to in some way, and this week, find a way to serve and serve them.

### WEDNESDAYS, 9AM CHECK-IN, 9:30AM DISCUSSION MOM TO MOM


