WELL PREPARED: WELCOMES IN JESUS

Room: Open the Door

WORD

Read [Revelation 3:14-21](#)

The Laodiceans were known for great wealth (v. 17), for their garment industry (v. 18), and for the eye ointment they produced (v. 18). They were proud of their self-sufficiency, they were rich and complacent as they enjoyed their wealth. What does Jesus suggest as an alternative?

Jesus knocked at the door to their hearts. What would it have looked like for them to let Him in?

Why might it seem scary or difficult to let Jesus in? And how does “I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends” sound different than what you might be afraid of?

What does it look like for you to open the door and let Jesus in, personally, and for your household? What is one thing you will do?

PRAY

Dear God, help us to open the door and welcome you. Turn our self-trust back to you. And open our eyes to the trappings of the world and how the Devil tempts us.

LOVE

Commit to one way you will support someone in your lifeGroup or household as you each seek to respond to Jesus knocking on the door of your heart.
